COURSE DESCRIPTION:

World History Honors provides coverage of world history from ancient times to the twentieth century with emphasis on the western world cultures. Honors classes will focus on analysis and research skills as they study the significant achievements and events of peoples, nations, and empires. This class will also focus on the Christian history and biblical principles that are interwoven throughout all of world history. Students will also study historical themes as they are developed to demonstrate the interrelations of ideas and events of the past and how they affect contemporary life.

COURSE GOAL:

A focus for this course is that students would gain a new appreciation for history and would begin to see historical figures as very real people. Students will learn to investigate for answers from a variety of sources, analyze research, and be able to present their conclusions in a logical manner. The students will gain a competent knowledge of events, peoples, causes, effects, and ideas that have shaped the world that we live in today through a Christian perspective.
