NOTEBOOK SIZE: ½”

Place the name of your state on the cover of your notebook. Make your cover as creative as possible.

Include the following in your notebook in the order listed:

1. Title Page: Double-spaced: Title; Your Name, Course; Mrs. Stewart; Date
2. Map of the state. Draw your map, nothing computer generated. Label the major cities, rivers, lakes, mountains, mountain ranges, deserts, plains, the capital city, etc. Type all the labeling for your map. Include a map key to designate the various items on your map. Use COLOR!
3. Brief summary of the history of the state. Include when the area gained its statehood (month, day, year). This must be at least one typed page.
4. Give a description of the terrain of the state; land area in square miles and include rank in size; and the climate types found in the state.
5. Include the most recent population figures (2000 or above); the major industries and the major agricultural products.
6. List the attractions of the state with information listed on each. (A minimum of four.)
7. Include the state nickname, flower, song, bird, tree, flag, and motto. (You may draw or find pictures of the bird, flower, tree, and flag.) Make sure you label each of the above.
8. Include five pictures of your state with captions under each picture.

You may use encyclopedias, maps, travel guides, internet, almanacs, or chambers of commerce to research your information.

Have a title page for each category.

All writing must be typed. Double-space all typed papers.

Do not write or put anything on the back of any page.

Make this as neat as possible.

Be creative with your pages in your notebook. Do not turn something in just printed off a source from the computer.

Extras add to your grade: matting, good lettering, color.

Presentation of material is very important.

You will be graded on neatness, creativity, correct information, following directions, and detail of information.
