

TEXAS HISTORY  
TEXAS STATE SYMBOLS POSTER PROJECT

Texas traditionally has recognized natural resources and wildlife found within the state by proclaiming them official Texas State symbols. Select five symbols to research from pages 684-686 in your textbook.

You will need one poster board for this project. On the front side of the poster board you will put the title of the project – Texas State Symbols. You will also put pictures or illustrations of the symbols you selected. These may be chosen from sources such as magazines, brochures, etc., printed from the internet, or done by hand. They are to be matted (backed) using colored paper and each is to be labeled. The poster may be vertical or horizontal.

On the back of the poster you will put your heading in the upper left corner. Research the symbols that you selected and write a brief, informative explanation/description/history of each one in paragraph form. This is to be titled, typed, and double-spaced. Mat this information and attach it to the back of the poster.

Presentation of material is very important. Make this as neat as possible and be creative with your project. Matting, good lettering, and color add to the over-all appearance of your poster. You will be graded on neatness, following directions, and detail of information.

This project will count as **two test grades**.
