

Animal Project Phase II – Discovery Poster

Objective - Make a discovery poster of the animal you chose for phase I. Discovery posters have flaps or pull down tabs that contain the information about the animal. The information is for the flaps are the facts from phase I.

1. The body (excluding legs and/or tail) of your animal has to be a minimum of ½ of a standard poster board. (15 points)
2. The animal should be colored so that it looks like the actual animal. The coloring can be done with pencils, paints or paper overlays. It may be helpful to start with poster board that is colored the same as the animal. (30)
3. The discovery flaps can be created in a variety of ways: (1) double layer the poster board and cut flaps in the top layer, (2) make flaps that are glued/taped neatly in appropriate places on the animal – flaps that are the splotches of a cow, (3) “window” or “door” flaps as shown in class or (4) tabs that are hidden behind the animal and can be pulled out or down. (30)
4. Poster must resemble the actual animal. (15)
5. All work must be neat: cut edges are smooth; coloring is correct, no excess glue or messy tape. (10)
6. Extra points can be earned for artistic or creative touches, but you cannot add something to the animal or its habitat that is in actuality incorrect. For example, you cannot put feathers on a butterfly or paint a cow blue. (5)
7. The typed information from phase I can be reduced to not less than font size 10. (10)
8. Students may see examples during enrichment.

Phase II may be turned in beginning March 16th. The last day phase II will be accepted is April 8th.

Phase II will count as a 100 point lab grade

Students should be prepared for phase III - a two minute oral report and presentation on April 8th

Phase I and II will be averaged for a test grade. Phase III will be used as up to 5 points of bonus on the test grade.
