ISRAEL PROJECT: DUE:

Write a research paper on the nation of Israel. The following topics must be covered in this paper in the following order:

History since 1948
Government
Armed Forces
Land
Economy
People, Population
Language
Religion
Closing**

Use HEADINGS for each section and number the pages.

You must have a minimum of ½ page on each topic.

Put this in your own words!!! MLA documentation where needed.

You must mount each page on construction or cardstock paper.

This must be typed, double-spaced, 12 pt. Times New Roman font, and a minimum of FOUR typed pages, a maximum of EIGHT pages.

Collect a minimum of 8 articles - maximum of 10 articles.

Collect articles beginning from January 2010 to present day:

Newspapers (Originals or Copies)

Magazines (Originals or Copies)

Internet—ONLY TWO INTERNET ARTICLES ALLOWED!!!! (Make sure they come from a reputable newspaper or magazine.) Print the entire page.

When collecting articles include source and date documentation. Include the original source and date from the article. No typed or handwritten source and date documentation.

Use only one article per page. Mount the article on the construction paper page.

HIGHLIGHT the word Israel or Israeli every time it appears in your articles.

The article must be about the nation of Israel, not just mentioned in the article.

Find 10 Bible verses concerning the nation, people, and children of Israel. (Not the

land of Israel)

Each must be a separate verse. Choose from more than one book in the Bible. Write out the entire verse. Be sure to put the verse in QUOTATION MARKS.

Double-space all typing.

Underline the word Israel in the verse or bold print it every time it is mentioned.

The word Israel must be in the verse.

Skip a line between each verse.

Include the address of each verse (Book, chapter, verse)

The order arrangement for this project is as follows:

Title Page

Israel Paper

Works Cited (for the sources used to write the paper not the sources used for your articles) (At least ONE book used as a source.)

Articles

Bible Verses

Map of Israel

Flag of Israel (Explain the meaning of the colors and design. Also, when was the flag officially adopted.)

Pictures of Israel (minimum of 5)

Pictures of the countryside; cities, culture.

Use captions with pictures.

REMINDERS:

Mount all pages.

Do not put anything on the back of a page.

Be sure to use a TITLE PAGE for each SECTION of your project.

Do not use staples on any part of this project.

Make sure all edges are taped or glued down.

Every page should be mounted separately including news articles.

No tape showing.

No pages in plastic sleeves or laminated except for the cover.

Do not use red or black construction paper.
