COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course covers world history from ancient times to the nineteenth century, with emphasis on the cultures of the western world. Traditional historical points of reference in world history as outlined in TEA objectives are identified as students analyze important events and issues in western civilization as well as in civilizations in other parts of the world. Students evaluate the causes and effects of political and economic imperialism and of major political revolutions since the 17<sup>th</sup> century. Students examine the impact of geographic factors on major historic events and identify the historic origins of contemporary economic systems. Students analyze the process by which democratic-republican governments evolved as well as the ideas from historic documents that influenced that process. Students trace the historical development of important legal and political concepts. Students examine the history and impact of major religious and philosophical traditions. Students analyze the connections between major developments in science and technology and the growth of industrial economies. This course will also focus on Christian history and biblical principles that are interwoven throughout all of world history. Students will also study historical themes demonstrating the interrelations of ideas and events of the past and how they affect contemporary life. Students will use the process of historical inquiry to research, interpret, and use multiple sources of evidence.

COURSE GOAL:

A focus for this course is that students would gain a new appreciation for history and would begin to see historical figures as very real people. Students will learn to investigate for answers from a variety of sources, analyze research, and be able to present their conclusions in a logical manner. The students will gain a competent knowledge of events, peoples, causes, effects, and ideas that have shaped the world that we live in today through a Christian perspective.
