THE BIBLICAL HISTORY OF MAN - CREATION THROUGH THE TOWER OF BABAL
2010-11

This project **IS NOT** required.
This project will count as a 25 point test grade.

1. Read Genesis 1 through Genesis 11:8. Then, create a poster depicting any theme **between Genesis 1:11 and Genesis 11:8**. The verse or verses you choose will be considered your primary verse or verses. Ideas for poster themes include: a day or several days of creation (not creation week), the Garden of Eden, the fall of man, information given within the genealogies, but not the genealogies themselves, the story of Noah and the flood, the story of the tower of Babal. If you have another idea for a theme from these passages **you must have approval** from the teacher **-failure to get this approval will reduce your grade by 50%. If you use verses other than Genesis 1:11-11:8 for your primary verse/verses your grade will be reduced by 50%.**
2. Create your poster using one-half of a poster board (no science boards!). You may cut a full size board in any manner you like as long as the area is equal to not less than one-half of a poster board.
3. You may use any of the following media on your poster: drawings colored with colored pencils; photographs, or pictures from magazines, newspaper, or an internet source.
4. You may combine the above in either a collection or collage.
5. All the work on your poster must be done neatly. Make sure that: 1) coloring is within the lines; 2) everything is secured using glue or double-stick tape and that there is no glue or tape residue around the pieces; 3) all lettering is typed as per instructions below, 4) all items are cut neatly and 5) all pictures, drawings, and photos are matted on construction paper or card stock. You do not necessarily have to use rectangle or square shapes for your pictures, drawings, photos, and mats, just be sure that the edges are neat.
6. The title must be matted. The title is to be typed in size 72 font. The title is to be creative and tell what your poster represents. A creative title for the activities of day five of creation week could be: "Fin and Feathers" as opposed to an uncreative title: "Day Five of Creation".
7. Posters must have the biblical verse(s) and reference typed and matted. The verses and reference are to be typed in size 14 font. For the above "Fin and Feathers" you would type out Genesis 1:20-23 and include the reference.
8. A minimum of six pictures or drawings are required. Pictures, drawings and photographs must not be smaller than 3" x 5" or 4" x 4" (a minimum total area of 15 square inches per picture). Your poster may be all pictures, all drawings, all photographs or a mixture of these. All pictures, drawings, and photographs must be matted on construction paper or cardstock.
9. The title, verse, and pictures/drawings/photos must fill the poster space so that there no large areas of poster showing around any one picture or the verse.
10. Additional points may be earned for the following as noted in the rubric.
11. Type your MLA heading in size 12 font and place it in the upper left corner of the back of the poster.
12. Due date: Not later than Monday, November 30th. Late work will not be accepted!! You may turn your poster in beginning Monday, November 23rd.
