**Course Title:** High School Bible

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Students will develop character and maturity in their Christian walk. Through the study, *The Inner Man*, students will learn biblical facts to change their inner being that their actions might be godly. Emphasis is placed on discipline, hard work and the dedicated study of the Bible and God's truths.

## CLASSROOM PROCEDURES:

Students will bring course text and all course materials to class every day. Students who are late will only be admitted with an office pass and must enter the classroom quietly. Bottled water is allowed in class – no sodas, coffee, snacks or gum is allowed. All assigned work is to be turned in on time. Students are to be respectful at all times. I expect students to engage in classroom discussions and participate in activities.

## ASSIGNMENTS:



***Most homework assignments can be completed during class.*** Outside reading will be assigned and we will often utilize Harkness Discussions during class time. Harkness discussions will be a homework grade, and all students are expected to participate. I hope to see sincere spiritual investment by the students.

All homework assignments are due at the beginning of class. Late work will be accepted within **24 hours** for **maximum 70%** credit. ***I will not accept late work more than 24 hours after it is due with the exception of a Friday due date. If the work is not turned in within the 24 hour time frame, it will be recorded as a zero.*** Please choose to turn in every assignment. A zero on any assignment, particularly a major assignment is hard to overcome. Staying organized and being disciplined is the key to being successful. Assignments must be done in black ink only or typed. All project reports will be typed.

If a student is absent due to a school activity or illness, projects **must** be turned in by due date without assessing a late penalty. There will be plenty of advance notice as to when all projects are due so that this should not be a problem. Homework and daily work will be due upon the student's return to class.

**Classwork and Homework** must be written in black ink, except where colored ink is required or typed. Assignments will be titled as follows:
