This will be a visual, oral presentation. You must use 4 x 6 note cards.

Note cards must be hand written.

The presentation must be a minimum of 10 minutes long. (3-4 minutes per civilization)

You must have visuals for each civilization something that the entire class can see. You might consider posters, objects, video, food, models, etc.

Be creative. Make it fun and interesting.

Your presentation and visuals will count as one test grade.

You will be graded on presentation, content of material, explanation and creativity.

Begin your presentation with an INTRODUCTION (Overview of the topic and civilizations); then proceed with your material on each civilization; end with a CONCLUSION (Sum it all up). Be sure to explain your visuals. Present your project and yourself in the best manner possible.

For your presentation you must dress up. No shorts or tennis shoes.

Research your information in books, textbooks, library, computer, encyclopedias, etc.
