

**WORLD HISTORY

Project Due:

You will choose one of the major religions of the world.

A written report is required. It must be typewritten and double-spaced. (12 pt. Times New Roman) It also must be bound; use a three brad folder.

You must include a title page following the format below:

Title page must be double-spaced.

The written report follows the title page. The report must be typed and double-spaced. Be sure to include an introduction and conclusion in your report. In your written report you will want to include such topics as history of the religion, beliefs and teachings, customs and ceremonies, how and where they worship, and how is salvation attained. Also, include a comparison (minimum of ½ page) to Christianity. Cover the topic thoroughly. This must be a minimum of FOUR full typewritten pages. Use a Heading in your report when changing topics. Make sure you indent new paragraphs.

The works cited page follows the written report. This must include all the sources you used for research for this report. Include your title (Works Cited) on this page. You must have a minimum of three sources. You must have at least ONE book source and ONE encyclopedia source.

After the works cited page, you will need five pictures or drawings depicting your religion. Mount one picture on a page matting each picture. Make sure you have a title for this section as well. Use captions for all pictures.

This project will count as two test grades.
