**Pre-K 3** focuses on building social and language skills while encouraging the students to practice self-control.

In class, they will work on fine motor skills that will help them succeed in their early school years.

**Pre-K 4** is centered on preparing the students for kindergarten. They will work on recognizing upper- and lower-case letters as well as associated sounds utilizing Neuhaus Phonics. Students will also learn the recognition of numbers. They will be introduced to word families and service words while working on their social and developmental skills.

## READING

Reading is taught with a foundation in phonics. Students learn to read one- and two-vowel word stories and stories with more challenging sounds. Teachers cultivate a love of reading through story time and regular school library visits.

## MATH

Through group learning sessions, students learn to recognize and understand number concepts up to 100. Teachers integrate manipulatives to enhance their knowledge of number combination families.

## SOCIAL STUDIES & SCIENCE

Through a Biblical worldview, students learn that God created all things with significance and a purpose.
